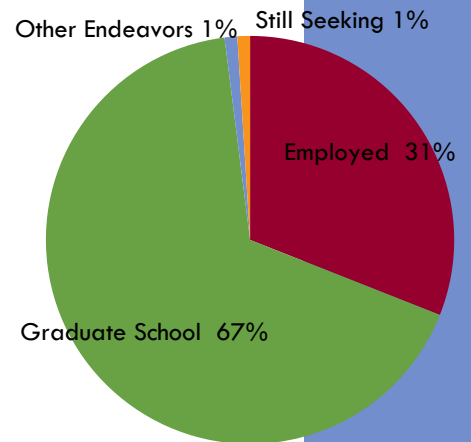


## Department of Biological and Environmental Engineering

### Bachelor of Science Degree Program

The Department of Biological and Environmental Engineering (BEE) offers two undergraduate curricula. Biological Engineering graduates receive an accredited Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in one of three concentrations: bioprocess engineering, bioenvironmental engineering or biomedical engineering. BEE, jointly with Civil and Environmental Engineering, also offers Bachelor of Science degree in Environmental Engineering. Graduates of the Environmental Engineering major have expertise in areas such as renewable energy, water resource engineering, bioremediation, and sustainable development.

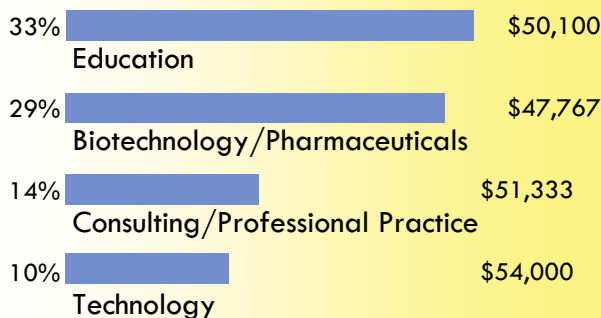

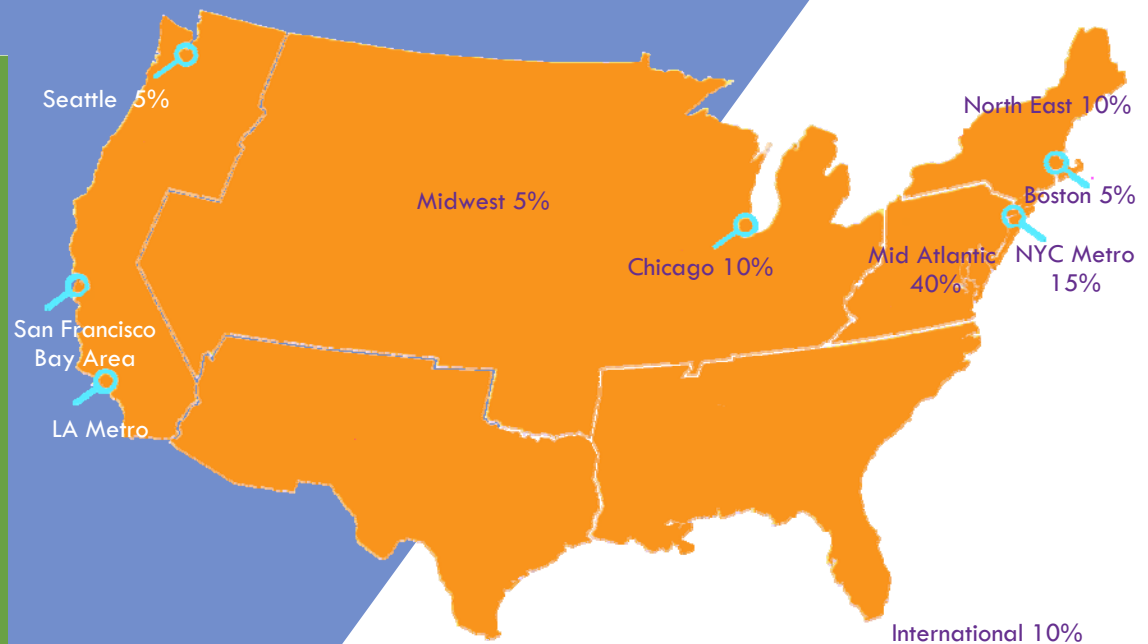
### Most Frequently Selected Fields, with average salaries

# Geographic Location of Employed Graduates

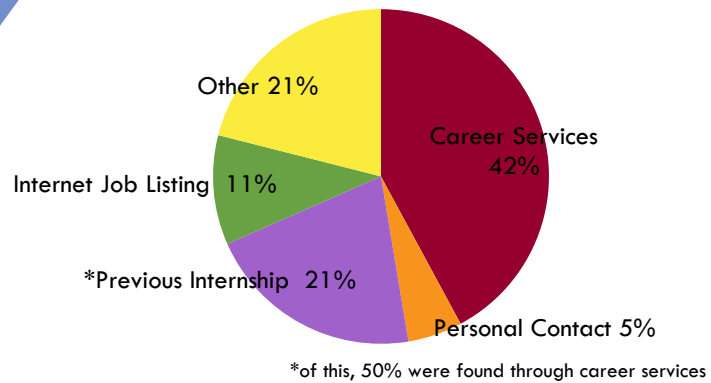
