Cornell CareerNet (CCNet)

[Cornell CareerNet](#) (CCNet) is a web-based system that Cornell Career Services uses to bring you career-related information, job and internship postings, alumni mentor contacts, and more. Resources for conducting career research are also available through the site. Cornell CareerNet replaces CornellTRAK. All students who were On-Campus Recruiting (OCR) eligible in CornellTRAK are eligible in the new system. Students new to the system should complete the [online tutorial](#).

The on-campus interviewing process runs from September through early December and then again from early February through mid-April. CDO staff facilitates employer visits, interviews, events, and presentations through this system. Check CCNet often to learn about summer and full-time jobs, as well as upcoming company presentations.
