New York State Department of Health

The New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) is offering up to 9 internships for undergraduate students majoring in science or public health during the summer of 2009. Designed to introduce undergraduates to potential careers in public health, internships will be available at the Department's Wadsworth Center Laboratories in Albany, NY and in NYS-DOH environmental health programs and county health departments across the state. The internships will run for 8 weeks beginning June 2009. Interns will receive a \$3,000 stipend for their work. The internships are sponsored by NYSDOH, the Association of Schools of Public Health and the Association of Public Health Laboratories and funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
