Opportunities

Landscape Opportunity

Unique opportunity for an individual to oversee and work first hand on a variety of landscapes in Central New York. These include: the grounds of two Syracuse based modern manufacturing facilities; a private lakeside residence, and three park and farm properties owned by a nonprofit restoration corporation in Cazenovia, NY. While care taking and maintenance are the primary focus for the residence and manufacturing properties, the remaining parcels provide development and implementation opportunities to a creative and hardworking individual committed to green space and community restoration initiatives.

Establish work plans for each phase of projects, including cost estimation, budget preparation, tracking and analysis. Target, select, but and install landscape plant material. Monitor nutrient status, diseases, insects, fungus and weed pests; treat as necessary. Implement an effective preventative maintenance plan for equipment including irrigation systems and arrange repairs as needed. Manage and supervise a part-time seasonal maintenance crew. Work with appropriate municipal authorities to obtain required permits. Manage and maintain proper record keeping of all related activities.

Qualifications: An undergraduate or graduate degree in Landscape Architecture or Horticulture, with a solid understanding of sustainable and universal design principals. Background in horticulture and grounds keeping practices and procedures, and a working knowledge of landscape irrigation, soil chemistry and structure, pest and disease control. Strong interest in and familiarity with landscape construction, both soft/hardscape.
