Conservation and Land Management (CLM) Intern - A five-month paid CLM internship to assist professional staff at the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), National Park Services (NPS), or U.S. Forest Service (USFS). Internships are mostly located in one of the thirteen western states, including Alaska. Responsibilities will include monitoring or assessing threatened and endangered species and habitats.
