Natural Area Ranger - City of Ithaca – Department of Public Works, Streets & Facilities – Successful interns will monitor activities in the City of Ithaca's natural areas for non-compliance with the rules and regulations governing the areas. The Rangers will advise users of the areas of the regulations, point out the hazards in the area, and advise users of the penalties for violations as well as contact appropriate law enforcement agencies to report acts of continued non-compliance.
