Interested in Research Experience?

Are you interested in doing research? If so, there are a multitude of opportunities for you here at Cornell. So, how do you find these positions?

1. One effective way is to contact a faculty member directly. If you identify a professor you would like to work with you can speak with them by making an individual appointment or visiting them during their office hours.
2. You can also explore opportunities by speaking with someone in a departmental office or with someone in the CALS or Barnes Hall career offices.
3. Another possible option is to gain credit through a 4990 course. This will allow you to conduct your own research project with a faculty mentor.
