AEM Internal (Intra) University Transfer Information Sessions Fall 2009

Students enrolled in a college at Cornell who are interested in transferring to the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences are required to attend an information session that covers the application process, timelines, and requirements. Internal transfer applications will be distributed at these sessions. Students who do not attend an information session will not receive an application.

Below is a list of the dates and times that the information sessions are offered. Please note that the Admissions Committee does not meet with students interested in pursuing the internal (intra) university transfer process on an individual basis.

Students interested in transferring to the Applied Economics and Management major must attend an AEM-focused session.

Attendance at one information session is mandatory. The Admissions Committee will not consider any applicant who has not attended an information session.

INFORMATION FOR POTENTIAL INTERNAL (INTRA) UNIVERSITY TRANSFER STUDENTS TO AEM

*The following requirements apply to all specializations in
Applied Economics and Management*

Minimum requirements for transfer consideration * :

- (1) Completed at least one year at Cornell at the date of application
- (2) Have a cumulative Cornell GPA of at least 2.75 [recommended 3.0]
- (3) Successfully completed ECON 1110 or 1120 with a C+ or better
[AP credit will be accepted]
- (4) Successfully completed one course in Calculus [AP credit will be accepted]
- (5) Completed at least TWO of the following courses with grades of B+** or better.
[AP credit may NOT be used for this requirement]
 - AEM 2100, MATH 1710, PAM 2100, ILR 2100 or ENGRD 2700, STSCI 2100
 - AEM 1200
 - AEM 2210 or HADM 2223
[Hotel School student may count HADM 1121 and 2221]
 - AEM 2300 [cross-listed as ECON 2300]
 - AEM 2400 or HADM 2241 [Hotel School students may count HADM 2243]
 - AEM 2500
 - ENGRI 1270 [may be counted by Engineering students only]
- (6) Essay that clearly articulates interest and experiences related to AEM
- (7) Submit resume
- (8) Submit 1 recommendation from an employer/supervisor (volunteer, paid work, internship, etc.)
- (9) Complete CALS Internal Transfer Application and submit by the deadline

**Courses taken prior to Fall 2009 must be completed with a B or better

*** The Admissions Committee reviews an applicant's entire transfer application packet. These course guidelines are one aspect of the application review components.**

*** Admission is a competitive process and there is no guarantee of acceptance.**
