



## **Internal University Transfer Information Sessions Fall 2009**

Students enrolled in a college at Cornell who are interested in transferring to the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences are required to attend a mandatory information session that covers the application process, timelines, and requirements. Internal university transfer applications will be distributed at these sessions. Students who do not attend an information session will not receive an application.

Below is a list of the dates and times that the information sessions are offered. Please note that the Admissions Committee does not meet with students interested in pursuing the internal transfer process on an individual basis.
